COUNTY STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE REPRESENTATIVE (SCC)

The County Constitution, dated March 2013 Convention Rev1, Article V, states:

The County Chair and Vice-Chair shall represent Summit County on the State Central Committee. The Party Chair shall hold an election in odd number years at the County Convention for other County representatives allowed by the State Central Committee.

The County SCC Representative must be a resident of Summit County, Utah, and a registered Republican. The County Party SCC representative is elected at the County Organizing Convention. The term of office shall be two years.

Duties of the Summit County Republican Party SCC Representative:

- Be a member of the State Central Committee
- Represent the Summit County Republican Party at State party SCC meetings
- Report meeting minutes taken from State SCC meetings to members of the County Executive Committee at the monthly meetings
- Work toward the good of the party platform
- Understand the party structure and know party rules
- Encourage voter registration
- Assist the County Leadership and Executive Committee in the administration of the County Party activities.
- Be involved in fund raising
- Attend Executive Committee Meetings and be a tie breaker vote when needed.
